$7 + 3 = 10 \rightarrow 10 - 7 = \square$

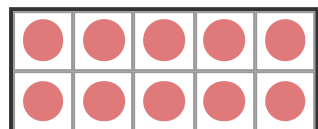

$8 + 2 = 10 \rightarrow 10 - 8 = \square$

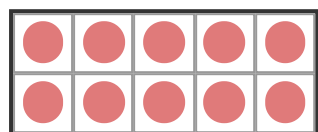
